PLEASE NOTE: Entries are catalogued in arrival order, so if you wish to be listed towards the front of the class please forward your entries to the Secretary early.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE class 13 and 13a: Veteran class 10 years and over, exhibit must be entire.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE neutered classes: Exhibits must be registered on the main registered as neutered with the ANKC to be eligible for entry and points toward the neutered champion title.

“	14 & 14 a	Bred by Exhibitor	For dogs 6 months and over. The exhibit must be owned and handled by the breeder of record
“	11, 11a, 18, 18a	Open	6 months or over
“	12 & 12a	Veteran	7 years and under 10 years
“	13 & 13a	Veteran	10 years and over
